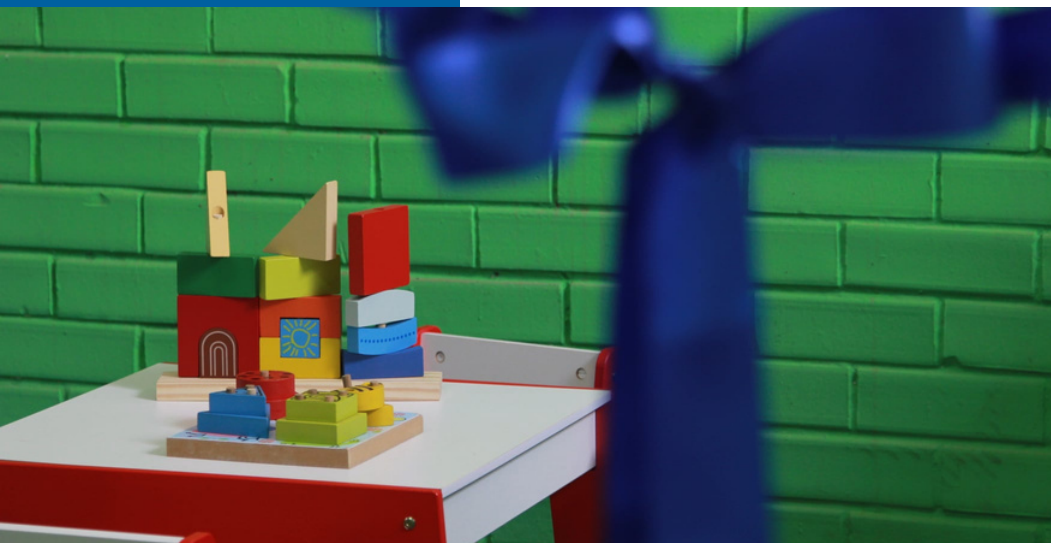

EAI HIGHLIGHTS

"Adote um Espaço Criança" Initiative

Promoted by the Office of International Affairs (EAI) in partnership with the Social Policies and Early Childhood Office, as well as the Secretariats of Social Development and Health, the initiative is part of the **"Vem Brincar Comigo" 2020 campaign**.

In the last few months, the project furnished - through cooperation with Embassies in Brasília - spaces in Basic Health Units (UBS) and Reference Centers in Social Assistance (CRAS) to receive children with comfort and leisure.

With donations from the Embassies of South Africa, Armenia, China, Ireland, Italy, Singapore, East Timor and Uruguay, as well as from the European Union Delegation in Brazil, 19 environments were set up, which are available to the population in different regions of the DF.

BRASILIA IN CITY NETWORKS

Global city networks are associations regulated by a set of specific rules around a common goal: to provide effective international cooperation among its members, generating mutual benefits and direct impact for their citizens. The actors reflect in their own structures the innovative models of interaction in the international system, characteristic of global governance.

Nowadays Brasília is a member of the World Association of Large Metropolises (Metropolis), of the United Cities and Local Governments network (UCLG), of the Common Market of Cities (Mercocities), and of the Union of Ibero-American Capital Cities (UCCI), among others. The insertion of the city in these networks has played a fundamental role in its internationalization process, becoming an important tool in the implementation of priority public policies and in the identification of management keys.

Brasília, through the forums, has managed to give visibility to the best local practices, which compete in calls for awards and financing for their execution, such as the application of the project "Systems of Green Areas and Free Spaces", from the Urban Development and Housing Secretariat, in the South-South Cooperation Program for Mercocities, and the application of local initiatives to the Guangzhou of Urban Innovation Award of the Metropolis network.

Thus, promising ideas from the GDF - such as the project "Brasília: a safe city for women", by the Women Secretariat - have gained traction through workshops and seminars for training civil servants and technical programs, such as the Municipal Training Program of the UCCI.

Organized by Brasília within the scope of the Union of Ibero-American Capital Cities (UCCI), through the EAI and the Controllship-General of the Federal District (CGDF), [the webinar](#) took place on the 24th and 25th of November. The initiative involved the participation of foreign representatives and cities, such as Bogotá / Colombia, Lima / Peru and Quito / Ecuador, allowing for the exchange of good practices on the theme of governance, a relevant issue in the good management of local governments.

Portugal Square Recovery

Located in the Southern Embassy Sector and inaugurated in 1972, the square began to be restored on March 10 of this year, under the coordination of the EAI in partnership with different agencies and Secretariats of the Federal District. [The initiative](#), which is also part of the commemorative actions for the 60th anniversary of Brasília, was made possible by the "Programa Mãos Dadas" of the Penitentiary Administration Secretariat (SEAPE), aimed at the re-socialization of detainees through the work provided in the renovation of community spaces.
